Hello all!

Most of us, including myself, are still waiting for spring to be sprung upon us before putting our two wheeled babies back on the road. Apparently, I think that's the thing to do. But having had a break in this brutal winter, there are a few brave souls emerging from their garages layered up and hitting the road on two wheels. There are some things to be aware of if you choose to do this early, and as always, be careful of the road conditions.

The first thing that comes to mind are some of the gaping potholes left in the wake of the receding glacial ice. Our roads are a wreck! While these can be annoying, even damaging to our four-wheeled winter rides, the threat to our bikes is many times greater. I saw one pothole recently that was about two feet wide and easily two car lengths long! Even smaller holes can damage tires, bend wheels, even cause us to lose control. Take your time and watch the pavement.

Second on my list is the myriad debris covering the road. I've seen everything from gravel and sand to car parts, even a large metal tow hook in the road. Tree branches, kids toys, litter, anything you can imagine is emerging from the melting snow. And even a dry-looking road will have random wet spots, which of course are bad enough, but can ice over when temps dip again. And an unseen culprit also lurks...salt! We rely on the salt to clear the roads for our cars all winter, but the salt that still coats the road is very slippery, and can unexpectedly take away your friction coefficient in a turn or quick stop. (Besides it's really tough on chrome).

The third thing I must emphasize is that many drivers are not yet expecting bikers. All year long we must be vigilant of the erratic drivers of cages, and avoid the chance of them trying to occupy the same road space we're using. At this time of year the threat is multiplied. A well known study called the Hurt Report (no pun intended) list right-of-way conflicts as one of the three leading causes of motorcycle fatalities. It's simple physics. Even a small car outweighs us by at least three times! As we have heard so many times before, now more than ever, stay out of their way and let them go, because right of way doesn't mean a thing when your motorcycle comes up against a car or truck.

From beginning to end, I think we all agree that a safe riding season is our common goal. Let's all have fun and be safe! If you ride early, realize the risks are even greater. We want you to ride with us throughout the season, so be extra careful.
